Christopher Kuehnelt: Restoration Director & 28 year member for the Lutze Housebarn –will be teaching use of the hand cranked boring machine to start the process of making a mortise as part of the timber framing process.

Alan Pape: Mentor & Advisor 33 years. Renown author of definitive restorative wood working skills. Al will be demonstrating the use of a froe and teaching participants to make cedar shake shingles.

Kathy Pearce: will have hands on demonstrations to learn how to peel logs, preparing them for timber framing with a variety of historic tools

Participants will also gain experience with various types of chisels and learn basics of tool care.

What will you learn?

- Proper use of tools
- Appropriate body mechanics
- Historic perspective of the craftsman
- Experience a video presentation of an old time barn raising
