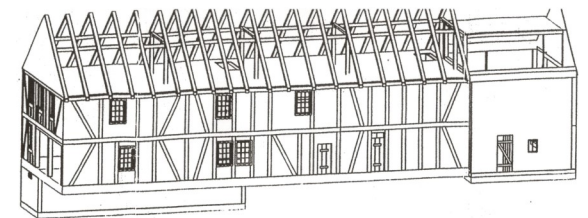

Built in 1849 by Gottlieb and Fredericka Lutze, the housebarn has been on the National Registry of Historic Buildings since 1984. The Lutze Housebarn is one of a few of this particular designs remaining in the United States!
